

Society and Culture Research Fund (Publishing Support Program)

The purpose of the fund is to support research initiatives in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. The use of funds for publishing support is designed to assist with the costs associated with translation, indexing, permissions, and the publication of monographs, edited books, or other academic publications.

Normally, the deadline is February 15th, and the maximum amount applicants can request is \$1,500. Applications must consist of one page explaining why the funds are needed and a statement on whether other support has been offered. Formal receipts must be attached and dated within the eligible period (which corresponds to a March to March period ending in the current year); if the receipt is not available at time of application, the applicant should confirm that one will be forthcoming by the end of March as required. Materials should be submitted as a single pdf to the Associate Dean Research: fassadr@dal.ca

Allocation of funds is determined by the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Research Development Committee, who will assess applications based on stage of application and potential contributions to scholarship (e.g., the advancement of knowledge, knowledge mobilization, traditional ways of knowing).

Eligibility: applicants must be 50% DFA or higher and meet the date requirements for receipts (above). No late applications can be accepted.
