POTENTIAL CAREERS

A similarly wide range of employers have sought graduates from each of our programs, including: municipal, federal or provincial government; NGOs such as Nature Conservancy, World Wildlife Fund, and the United Nations Environment Programme; and, environmental consulting. Our thesis-based program is more suited, however, to doctoral studies, and careers in academic teaching and/or research. Our Alumni Mentoring Program will help widen the possibilities for a meaningful career after graduation.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must satisfy the general requirements for admission to the Faculty of Graduate Studies and provide proof of funding and language test as necessary (international students). A TOEFL of 100 or IELTS of 7.5 is required.
