

GRADUATE STUDENT FUNDING INFORMATION SHEET – EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO READ
TUITION AND FEE DEDUCTIONS:

The total term tuition and fees will be deducted from the term amount of funding before the calculation of monthly payments; however, the deduction will be indicated on your cheque stub in the first month of each term. If you haven't done so, please submit a direct deposit form (https://cdn.dal.ca/content/dam/dalhousie/pdf/dept/hr/Payroll-and-Information-Services/bank_deposit_application_form.pdf) to the payroll office before the start of your first term.

The worksheet on the bottom of this sheet will assist you in calculating the approximate monthly amount of your award. If the amount you receive is significantly less or more than you have calculated double-check your calculations, and if there is still a discrepancy, you must contact your graduate coordinator immediately.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:

Registering students who are not Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents are required to pay an additional fee referred to as an "international differential fee". The international differential fee amounts can be found on the Student Accounts website (www.dal.ca/studentaccounts). Differential fees will be deducted from your scholarship.

DIFFERENTIAL FEES FOR NON-CANADIAN GRADUATE STUDENTS MUST BE PAID FOR:

- Full-Time Master's student (except Oral Surgery) 2 years (or equivalent)
- Full-Time Master's student Oral Surgery 4 years
- Part-Time Master's student 6 years
- Full-Time PhD student (following a Master's degree) 3 years
- Full-Time PhD student (following a Bachelor's degree) 4 years
