

NEW STUDENTS

Sign into [DalOnline](#) using your NetID. Select **Academic Timetable**, then **2023/2024 Summer** for summer registration, **2024/2025 Fall** for fall registration, or **2024/2025 Winter** for winter.

There are two types of courses for PhD in Health students. The first ensures that you continue to receive your scholarship payments and the second are required courses. Please note that the CRN numbers for the PhD Health courses and course to ensure scholarship receipt can be found on page 2.

1. To ensure that you receive your scholarship payments, register for **Registration Course-Graduate – REGN 9999** every term.*
2. Required courses:
 - a) **For students in the two-year residency program only:**
HLTH 6000 Fall and Winter
HLTH 6100 Fall and Winter
Please note that these courses run concurrently on alternate weeks. Final grades will be received at the end of the Winter term.
 - b) **For students in the three-year residency program only:**
HLTH 5101 (Fall)
HLTH 5102 (Winter)
 - c) **Electives: You should discuss your choice of electives with your supervisor.** A list of options can be found in the [Course Outlines](#) section of the PhD in Health webpage. In some cases, if you plan to register in a course, you will need to contact the instructor. The links for the Faculty members in each college and school can be found [here](#).

If you plan to register for either Independent Study/Directed Reading course HLTH 7001 and/or 7002, please complete the applicable form signed by both you and the instructor and send it with a copy of the full course syllabus to phdhealth@dal.ca. The course curriculum guidelines can be found under [Course Outlines](#), and the required form under [Forms and Documents](#) on the PhD in Health webpage for current students and supervisors.

FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS

Once all coursework has been completed, you **MUST continue to register for REGN 9999, the Comprehensive exam course (HLTH8000) and Doctoral Thesis (HLTH 9530)**. Once your comprehensive exams are complete, you must continue to register for **REGN 9999 and Doctoral Thesis (HLTH 9530) each term thereafter** (including Summer*) until you have completed your PhD.
