Guidelines for Using the IPHE Course Designation	<i>Responsible Unit:</i> Faculty Council FH IPE Coordinator	<i>Amendments:</i> Formatting, March 2018

- 1) The development of an IPHE course has involved collaboration among at least two FHP units.
- 2) The content/objectives of the course relate directly to three or more health professions (in multiple FHP units) or other professional collaborations (for example, education, health informatics, law, etc.),
- 3) The pedagogy of the course provides various professional perspectives on the content,
- 4) The course is open to students from different professions in multiple FHP units,
- 5) There is a reasonable expectation (supported by letters from relevant Directors/Chairs of relevant Schools/Departments) that students from three or more professions in multiple FHP units will in fact register in the course, and
- 6) Students from different professions will be required to work together on projects/assignments (i.e., sitting in a classroom together is not sufficient).
