Students in the Faculty of Health Professions **must register for IPHE 4900 each term** while registered in their respective degree program. This is a non-credit requirement that has no course fee. Students will take part in interprofessional collaborative learning experiences that will be outlined by the School each year.

Honours notes:

- Students planning to apply to honours should take HAHP 3100 in fall term of their third year
- Application deadline for honours is November 15th of 3rd year (please see an advisor for admission requirements).
- Students in honours must take HPRO 4101 & HPRO 4102 (honours thesis). For students in the Research stream, HPRO 4101 is required and HPRO 4102 can be used as either an open or health related elective. Students in the Community stream taking honours can use HPRO 4101 + 4102 as either open or health related electives
