** WRITING REQUIREMENT COURSE OPTIONS:

- English: ENGL/CRWR 1030.06 (single term)*;
 or two of: ENGL1005.03, ENGL 1015.03,
 ENGL 1025.03, ENGL1040.03, ENGL 1050.03,
 ENGL 1100.03
- **German:** GERM 1026.03 **and** 1027.03
- History: HIST 1022.03 and 1023.03; or HIST 1510.06 (single term)*
- **Journalism:** JOUR 1002.03 and 1003.03

- Oceanography: OCEA 1001.03 and 1002.03
- Performance: PERF 1000.03 and 1 of 1001.03 or 1002.03
- Philosophy: PHIL 1810.03 and 1820.03
- Political Science: POLI 1001.03 and 1002.03
- Russian Studies: RUSN 1020.03 and 1070.03
- Sustainability: SUST 1000.06 (single term)*

Note: * 6-credit-hour courses in a single term are the equivalent of two courses in the same term; these cover both Writing Requirement courses for the year. To accommodate a 6 credit-hour writing requirement in the fall term (SUST 1000 or ENGL/CRWR 1030), SOSA 1002 or ECON 1101 would have to move to the winter term. If students choose HIST 1510 in winter term for the writing requirement, ECON 1102 or SOSA 1003 would have to move to fall. These changes may not be possible if the switch creates a conflict with a required LEIS or MGMT course.
