## \* Elective Notes

- \* Writing Requirement: The equivalent of 6 credit hours (2 half credits) must be chosen from the list of specific courses identified as Writing Classes in the Dalhousie calendar.
- \*Open Electives: The equivalent of 21 credit hours (7 half credits) chosen from all classes offered at the University; 12 credit hours (4 half credits) must be above the 1000 level. Courses can be chosen from any subject area. Students are encouraged to select <u>at least one</u> elective related to the Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action and/or equity, diversity and inclusion more broadly. Please consider IPHE 2201 (Intro to Aboriginal Peoples' Health and Healing), HPRO 3360 (Multicultural Health Promotion Research and Policy), HLTH 2000 (Centering Black Canadian Health), or KINE 3200 (Sociocultural Issues in Physical Activity) or consult an advisor for other options.
- **\*MGMT/LEIS Electives**: The equivalent of 9 credit hours chosen from any MGMT or LEIS course not already required for the degree.

NOTE: There cannot be more than 12 credit hours total of electives at the 1000 level (this includes all electives, both Open and MGMT/LEIS).

**Honours** - Students may apply for honours by **November 15<sup>th</sup>** of the year before their final year of the program. If accepted, students will proceed by taking LEIS 4101 in the subsequent winter term and LEIS 4102 in the fall of their final year. Both courses can count toward electives.

To be eligible for honours, students must complete HAHP 3100/HLTH 3010 before or during the fall term in which the application is due. A grade of B or better in this course is required, as is a cumulative GPA of 3.70 over the previous 45 credit hours and a grade of B or better in a course most related to the proposed thesis topic. Students with a GPA between 3.50 and 3.70 may also apply – see an advisor for additional details. To apply for honours, please see a HAHP academic advisor.
