* Elective Information

<u>Open Electives</u>: 12 credit hours of the 27 credit hours must be above the 1000 level. Students are encouraged to select <u>at least one</u> elective related to the Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action and/or equity, diversity and inclusion more broadly. **IPHE 4900 - Interprofessional Health Education Portfolio

Students in the Faculty of Health Professions must register for IPHE 4900 each term while registered in their respective degree program. This is a non-credit requirement that has no course fee. Students will take part in interprofessional collaborative learning experiences that will be outlined by the School each year.

Honours - Students may apply for honours by **November 15**th of the year before their final year of the program. If accepted, students will proceed by taking LEIS 4101 in the subsequent winter term and LEIS 4102 in the fall of their final year. Both courses can count toward electives. Students must obtain a minimum grade of B in 4101 to be eligible to continue in 4102.

To be eligible for honours, students must complete HAHP 3100 before or in the fall term the application is due. A grade of B or better in this course is required, as is a cumulative GPA of 3.70 over the previous 45 credit hours. To apply for honours, please see a HAHP academic advisor.

Certificates – Students may want to consider adding a certificate to the degree. For more information on certificates available at Dal, please see the <u>Academic Calendar</u>. Important to note is that not all certificates are available to all students at Dal and depending on certificate requirements, it may not be possible to fit requirements for all certificates into the 120 credit hours needed for the TR degree. To discuss further, please contact an advisor.

First Aid /CPR – Please note that students must ensure they have a minimum of Standard First Aid and Level C CPR current certification **prior to going on internship**. Students are responsible for obtaining this certification on their own and a copy of certification will be required prior to obtaining internship approval.

GPA Requirement for Internship – students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher prior to the enrolling in LEIS 4598.15 (internship).
