Application Requirements:

- Complete the application form.
- Include current <u>resume</u>: inclusive of education, employment experience, skills, honors and awards, extracurricular activities, additional training, and community service.
- Include <u>two written references</u> from local community member (e.g., school, community group, coach, employer). Must not be family member.
- O Include <u>written submission</u> based on the outline below.

Written Submission Outline:

Describe why you have chosen a career in nursing, and how your role as a Registered Nurse will positively contribute to your community. Use references from the literature and other sources and cite properly. Zero tolerance for <u>plagiarism</u>. Please use size 12 Times New Roman font, double space, 1-inch margins. Submission should be 3-6 pages long (not including references).
