Courses are offered online using Brightspace. There is a high level of interactivity in all courses, and students are expected to fully engage with the content as well as with other students. Discussions are in small and large groups on discussion boards. Other social media and interactive tools are used to deliver content.

In order to maintain the integrity of part-time students' academic program, classes are taken in a prescribed sequence. The two program options are:

- 1. **Thesis Option:** You are required to take 1 half-credit elective and do 1 full-credit thesis The thesis option requires the student to extend their time in the program by at least six months full-time and eighteen months part-time.
- 2. **Course-based Option**: You are required to take 3 electives. Students choose which electives they want to take and when. Generally, four electives are offered each academic year, one in the winter term and four in the summer terms.

All students are required to successfully complete 5.0 credits for the MSW program.
