

KINE 4713 – Safety/Ethics in Sports

The purpose of this course is to provide students with an introduction to safety and ethics in sport. This course will explore the emergence of safe sport as a societal issue; the current realities of safe sport and other ethical sporting issues in Canada; and the future of safety in sport. Students will explore measures designed to prevent and address maltreatment in sport. Consideration of key stakeholders' interests will be examined with particular attention paid to the athlete's voice.
