** Writing Requirement Course Options:

There are many options from which to choose for the writing requirement course. This link – Writing Requirements - will take you to a page that lists all courses that count as a writing requirement. Scroll down the page until you see the heading "Writing Course Requirements". Availability of each course in this list will vary from year to year so please check the academic timetable for availability of the course for the 2024/25 academic year.

<u>Note</u>: 6 credit-hour courses in a single term are the equivalent of two courses in that term and would complete the Writing Requirement plus an Open Elective. To accommodate a 6 credit-hour writing requirement in the fall term (SUST 1000, HIST 1510, or ENGL/CRWR 1030), please consult an advisor for assistance with your course plan/schedule.

Some courses in the Writing Requirement list above may have pre-requisites - please check before selecting your course. For example, OCEA 1002 cannot be taken unless OCEA 1001 has been completed so if looking to do OCEA for the writing requirement, a student would need to select OCEA 1001in the fall semester.
