## **\*\* IPHE 4900 (00) – Interprofessional Health Education Portfolio**

Students in the Faculty of Health must register for IPHE 4900 each term while registered in their respective degree program. This is a non-credit requirement that has no course fee. Students will take part in interprofessional collaborative learning experiences that will be outlined by the School each year.

**GPA (Internship)** – Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 prior to enrolment in LEIS 4597.15 (Internship).

**First Aid/CPR** – Students must have a minimum Standard First Aid and Level C CPR current certification **prior to going on internship**. Students are responsible for obtaining this certification on their own and a copy of certification will be required prior to obtaining internship approval.

## **\* Elective Notes**

\* **Writing Requirement:** The equivalent of 3 credit hours (1 half credit) must be chosen from the list of specific courses identified as Writing Classes in the Dalhousie calendar.

\* **Open Electives:** The equivalent of 27 credit hours (9 half credits) chosen from all classes offered at the University; 15 credit hours (5 half-credits) must be above the 1000 level. Courses can be chosen from any subject area.

\* **EDIA Elective:** Any course from the following list:

\* **MGMT/LEIS Electives:** The equivalent of 6 credit hours chosen from any MGMT or LEIS course not already required for the degree.

**NOTE: There cannot be more than 12 credit hours total of electives at the 1000 level (this includes all elective categories).**

**Honours** - Students may apply for honours by **November 15<sup>th</sup>** of the year before their final year of the program. If accepted, students will proceed by taking LEIS 4101 in the subsequent winter term and LEIS 4102 in the fall of their final year. Both courses can count toward electives.

To be eligible for honours, students must complete HAHF 3100 or HLTH 3010 (grade of B or higher) before or during the fall term in which the application is due. A cumulative GPA of 3.70 over the previous 45 credit hours and a grade of B or better in a course most related to the proposed thesis topic are also required. Students with a GPA between 3.50 and 3.70 may also apply – see an advisor for additional details or to get an application started.

## **Majors/Minors/Certificates**

Students in BSCRBM are able to consider a major through the BManagement side of the program, a minor through the combined program and/or a certificate but none of these options are required. To discuss any of these options further, please contact an advisor.

## **Study Abroad**

If interested in a study abroad experience, please meet with an advisor to see if this can fit into your course plan. Students normally would do a study abroad in the winter semester of year 3 or 4 but advanced planning is essential so it's a good idea to look into this during or before first semester of year 2.
