4. Specialty Certificates: Certificate eligibility includes successful completion of the two required elective courses AND completion of clinical work within a related specialty area during clinical placement for Clinical Integration V (NURS4715).
  - a. Students hoping to be eligible for certificates at graduation must declare their certificate goals when applying for clinical placement in NURS4715. Students hoping to receive a specialty certificate upon graduation must apply for their specialty clinical area when making clinical selections for NURS4715. All efforts are made by clinical placement office to place students within their specialty areas during NURS4715.
  - b. Please note: If you reject a specialty placement when offered, you will not be eligible to receive a certificate at graduation.
  - c. If the clinical placement office is not able to secure a specialty placement for you, you will be expected to demonstrate use of specialty knowledge in the area you are provided (method to be discussed with your N4715 course professor).
