Yarmouth Campus Residence

About Beulah Raymond Hall

- Beulah Raymond Hall is owned and operated by Nova Scotia Health and in partnership with Dalhousie University provides residence for students. The building is located adjacent to the Yarmouth Regional Hospital.
- The two lower floors of the building contain faculty offices, classrooms and lab spaces.
- Student rooms are found on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th floors.
- Each residence floor provides a kitchen, lounge and two washroom spaces
- Laundry is available in the basement for \$1.00 per load.
- Snack and drink vending machines are located in the basement
- Tunnel access between the School of Nursing and Yarmouth Regional Hospital (under construction)
- Watson Caie Amirault Learning Center on 2nd floor– These library rooms consist of a computer lab, quiet study room and collaborative spaces





Single Room

\$375/month

Standard furnishings include a twin bed, desk, chair and wardrobe. These items must remain in the students' room





Double Room

\$350 (Shared)

\$425 (Not Shared)

Standard furnishings include two twin beds, desk, chair and wardrobes. These items must remain in the students' room

*2nd bed not guaranteed in all double rooms with single occupancy





Meal Options



- No meal plan options available for Yarmouth Campus
- Kitchen facilities provided on each residence floor. Provided items include stove, fridge, deep freezer, pots, pans, dishes, cutlery, drinkware and various small appliances.
- Access to Yarmouth Regional Hospital Cafeteria.
- Vending machines available in basement of School of Nursing and lobby of Yarmouth Regional Hospital.
- Food delivery services available to the campus(DoorDash)



Student Lounge's

Lounges provide a comfortable space to relax and socialize with other students. These spaces include comfortable seating, a TV and large meeting table.



There are two washrooms on each residence floor. Washrooms contain toilet stalls, shower stalls and a bathtub stall. All washrooms are co-ed.





Watson Caie Amirault Learning Centre

The Learning Centre is available on the 2nd floor. There is a computer lab, quiet study room and two collaborative spaces for students. Reserve books are available to use or for loan.





Other Information

- A unique benefit to the Yarmouth campus is the ability to have pets in residence. This is **only** done through an application and approval process and only a maximum of two animals on 3rd and 4th floor each (cats or small caged animals)
- Residence applications received before June 1st will be guaranteed a room.
- Priority for residence placement is given to students whose primary residence is located more than 100 kilometers from the Yarmouth Campus, as well as to those enrolled in a full-time course load.
- A variety of factors determine room assignments so students may not always be placed in their preferred room type. All efforts will be made to assign students to room that meet their preferences but it is not always possible due to space limitations.
