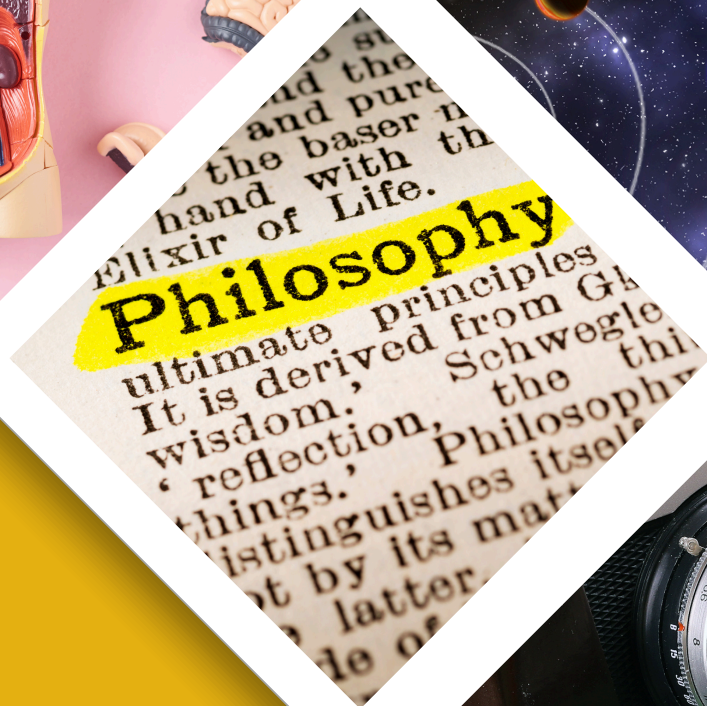

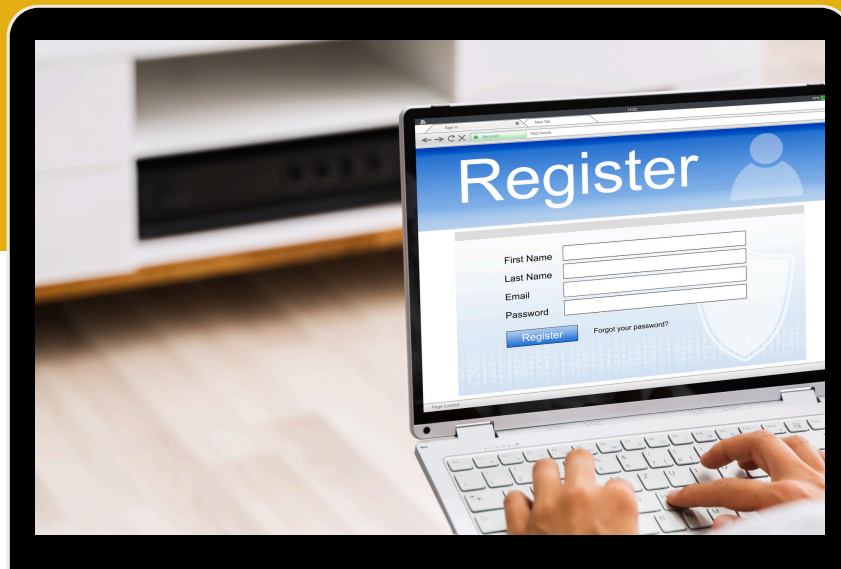




It can be difficult to find an open elective to fit your already busy schedule. This guide was prepared to help students who cannot find an on-campus elective. We are not deterring students from choosing an on-campus elective, but merely providing a list of some other online options. *(Please note we cannot guarantee available seats in all courses listed)*

Here are some important things to also keep in mind when selecting an elective:

- Choose something of interest to you, as you want to ensure you do well and keep your GPA up.
- Be mindful of the add drop dates in the [Dalhousie Academic Calendar](#) in case you start the course and decide it is not the right fit for you.
- **ANAT 1010** is an exclusion for School of Health Science students and will not count towards your degree if you decide to take this as an elective.
- Be sure to check if there are prerequisites for the elective you choose before registering.

- Please note, you may choose a Faculty of Health course as an open elective as long as you meet your Faculty of Health elective requirements as well. But open electives do not meet the requirements of a Faculty of Health elective.
