1. Email the reference desk at your home library. Find your library's email address from the links below!
2. Find your subject liaison librarian (see the links below this video). Make an appointment to discuss your research or get help over email!
3. Use Live Help chat to get help right away. Live Help is staffed by libraries across Nova Scotia. Great for quick questions!
4. Find the Subject Guide for your discipline to get started on your own. Subject guides contain resources suggested by your subject librarian.
5. Watch short video tutorials to learn how to use the library. Short videos can help you get started!
