(a) A **cover letter** that includes, among other things, the following:

- Legal name
- Mailing address, including apartment number, if applicable
- Phone number(s)
- Preferred email address

(b) Provide **biographical information** to be used by Esri Canada for the successful applicant:

- Current enrolment program.
- Expected graduation year and term.
- Level of experience with components of the ArcGIS platform.

(c) **The following** which will be delivered to *Esri Canada Education and Research* for winner

- **Resume**
- Academic **transcript** (unofficial copies from Dalonline are acceptable).
- **Poster** demonstrating your use of Esri technology.
- Story map, app or written report **describing the work** in your poster.

## Submission Deadline is April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026
