

Entrepreneurship and Innovation Certificate

The Entrepreneurship and Innovation Certificate will provide students with an opportunity to learn and develop skills related to innovation and entrepreneurship, starting with ideation (innovation, creativity, design thinking), continuing with launching a new venture, and ending with managing a new venture.

Required Courses (9 credit hours):

- MGMT 2902 Innovation: An Introduction to Design Thinking
- MGMT 3907 New Venture Creation
- MGMT 4901 Managing the Venturing Process

Students must obtain a minimum grade of B- for all courses counted toward the certificate.

To graduate with the Certificate, students must apply to graduate with a Certificate per the timelines determined by the Registrar's Office.
