

German Government Funding for Hydrogen Projects in Canada

Description

On October 4, the German government announced its funding guideline for international green hydrogen projects, through which non-repayable grants of a total of up to EUR 350 million will be provided for green hydrogen production, storage, transport, and application as well as research projects. The funding guideline aims at projects outside the EU and EFTA. In consortia, only a company with headquarters in the EU and operations in Germany is eligible to apply. The maximum grant per project is EUR 15 million. The first call for proposals closes at the end of October 2021, followed by two additional calls in December 2021 and February 2022.

This webinar will provide an overview on the funding guideline and dig into its details as well as provide an opportunity for interested stakeholders from Canada and Germany to explore the potential for joint projects funded by the guideline.
