


- Almost 1,000 publicly funded research institutions


## Pillars of the German research sector

- 2.95 million students (2021/22),
  ~ 416,000 international (~14%)
- ~ 28,000 international doctoral candidates
- Most popular non-English-speaking study destination
- Fourth most popular study destination worldwide
- Almost 40% of German students study abroad
















**Award?** universities

Deadlines? Application submitted by German host

## Humboldt Research Fellowship (Experienced Researchers)

In Brief
Supports research stays of between 6 and 18

months in Germany

Who?
Highly-qualified scholars in all fields who received their

PhD no more than 12 years previous

**Duration?** 6-18 months, divisible into up to 3 blocks

Terms of € 3,170 / month + family allowance, insurance, etc.
Award?

Deadlines? Applications accepted on rolling basis







# Learn German: Online German Courses for Faculty

Who?
Scholars who hold a PhD (or equivalent) and have been

working in research or teaching full-time at a Canadian

university or research institution for at least two years

Duration? Courses run 5, 8 or 16 weeks

Terms of DAAD covers full costs of course participation

Deadline? April 1

Deadlines? Short-term: November and May;

One Year: November only




