## Survey on cloud services in research now open

The Researcher Council Cloud Survey Steering Group has launched a survey to better understand how Canadian researchers use the Alliance community cloud or commercial cloud services and to inform the development of a National

Cloud Strategy. Researchers and research staff from all disciplines are encouraged to fill out the survey. Findings will help to identify gaps in cloud service provision and improve the functionality of the Alliance Cloud, to better serve the research community. Fill out the survey here. ### Launch of the Alliance Research Software Strategy Working Group

The Alliance Research Software (RS) Strategy Working Group held its first meeting in December. The group comprises representatives from key stakeholder groups who will draft a national RS strategy for 2023-2030. The group also aims to outline scenarios and recommendations for the Alliance's RS services and funding opportunities; facilitate involvement of the Canadian RS community in the Alliance's RS activities; and identify opportunities for collaboration among Canadian organizations and international groups. There will be an opportunity to provide feedback on an initial draft strategy—stay tuned!

#### Survey on joint multilateral funding initiative on research software

Take part in this survey from the Research Software Funders Forum to help a group of international funding agencies design a joint multilateral funding initiative on RS. The survey aims to understand the needs of researchers

regarding funding the development and enhancement of RS and the associated ecosystems (e.g., training, education and policy).

### Lunaris—new platform for data discovery coming soon

The Alliance Research Data Management team, in collaboration with partners of the Federated Research Data Repository (FRDR), are busy developing Lunaris, our new platform for data discovery. Set to launch on March 29, Lunaris will integrate both text- and map-based searching to offer a dynamic and intuitive discovery experience for researchers. Need a place to deposit data? FRDR will continue to operate alongside Lunaris as a dedicated repository service for researchers.
