Conference Overview

The **Sustainable Oceans Conference** is the only student-led conference of its kind in Atlantic Canada. It is supported by the **Sobey Fund for Oceans**—a partnership between Dalhousie University, the Marine Affairs Program, and WWF Canada. The conference aims to explore multi-disciplinary approaches to creating healthy oceans for a sustainable future. The conference is a **free**, **public event** that brings together students and faculty, members of the marine community, and the general public alike.

The theme of this year's conference is *One Ocean, Infinite Connections*. The overall goal of the 8th annual conference is to **build bridges** between diverse knowledge groups, encouraging people to consider a new knowledge perspective towards the ocean. The conference will highlight how these connections can be fostered to result in holistic ocean stewardship.

Prizes will be awarded for the top speakers and poster presentations. A \$30 printing stipend will be provided for poster presentations.

Interested participants are asked to submit an abstract (250 words) detailing their research, the actual or anticipated results, as well as major take-home messages.
