Project Grant Updates – Fall 2016

Some statistics:

2884 Applications
1331 peer reviewers
>12,000 reviews

- 43% of applications moved forward based on whether they:
 - Were within the top-ranking (~30% across clusters);
 - Were within the top ~30% within their cluster;
 - Had large discrepancies between reviews; or
 - Were flagged by the Competition Chairs (and not captured as above)
- In addition, all (100) applications in the Indigenous Health Researcher Cluster moved on to Stage 2



Project Grant Updates – Fall 2016

- Notification regarding Stage 2 the week of March 20th
- Notification did not include written reviews or ranking information
- Full reviews and decision documents will be available on May 15, 2017
- Face-to-face reviews are taking place April 19th May 5th
- 16 to 30 reviewers per panel depending on original cluster size
 - Primary and secondary reviewer for each application
- Talk of at least maintaining 13-14% success rates
 - Possible "re-distribution" of funds (Foundation to Project)



Project Grant – Spring 2017

No substantive changes from the Fall application process

Anticipated Notice of Decision: November 23,

Funding Start Date: October 1, 2017

 NOTE: CIHR is working towards 6-month cycles between competitions (2 per year); no dates yet for a Fall 2017/Winter 2018 Competition but expect December deadline.

College of Reviewers

- Enrollment commences June 2017
- College members will be supported through predictable workloads, meaningful recognition programs, and learning / mentoring opportunities
- First round of invitations: Meet criteria + recent reviewer

College of Reviewers

- College Chairs will be directly involved in overseeing the enrollment process
- College Chairs are also advising CIHR on peer review practices, with strong focus on second and third project competitions
- Competition (i.e. "Cluster") Chairs to be solicited for feedback at Spring College Chairs meeting
 - Matching; Review Quality; Capacity Building

Internal Peer Review Process

- Important to ensuring that only high-quality applications are submitted to CIHR
- A collaborative (Health Faculties; IWK; NSHA; DRS) internal peer review process was piloted (under a bit of duress!) in the Fall 2016 Project competition
- Will utilize a "Panel" of experienced researchers as reviewers (we're aiming for 50!)
- Panel "Chair": Gerry Johnston



Internal Peer Review Process

- Researchers will communicate through their respective research offices
- Reviewers will NOT be anonymous
- Timelines
 - ~6 weeks in advance: Title, lay summary, expertise key words
 - ~5 weeks in advance: Draft proposal to research office
- ~3.5 weeks in advance: Written, informal (bulleted) feedback provided based on Project grant criteria (2-3 reviewers);
- ~2.5 weeks in advance: "Meritorious" applications proceed to face-to-face panel discussion (with applicant present); notes generated by scientific officer will be provided to applicant
- Applicants will be expected to respond to comments and meet with the primary reviewers as necessary

- Tuesday, May 16 Application submission with CIHR comments
- May 24 to May 26 Internal F2F panel discussions
- Monday, June 5 Internal DRS Deadline

Need Some Incentive?

33 of 74 applications overall (Dal + Hospitals) moving to Stage 2: **45%** [National success for stage 2 – 44%]

20 of 32 internally peer reviewed and submitted applications moving to Stage 2 – 63%

20 of 29 "positively" internally reviewed and submitted applications to Stage 2 – 69% (if 3 triaged applications hadn't been submitted anyway!)

15 of 19 face-to-face (panel) review and submitted applications moving to stage 2 – 79%

(Note: not all applications submitted for internal review went to an additional face-to-face panel, mostly for logistical reasons)

13 of 42 applications NOT submitted for internal peer review moving to Stage 2 – 31%



DRS Review & Deadlines

- Internal DRS deadline is June 5th for Project Grants, if participating in peer review.
 Non peer-reviewed grants are due May 29th
- Our review focuses more on the following:
 - * eligibility of the researcher
 - * completeness
 - * budget and budget justification
 - * Knowledge translation
 - * general lay person comments
