PD-related diseases

SEED FUNDING for novel, high-risk, high-reward translational research on neurodegenerative diseases of aging

Maximum **\$200,000** over up to **18 months**

NEW FOR 2017

- Increased funding amount (up to \$200,000/project)
- Applicants may appear in any role on any number of LOIs
- Multiple calls per year, alternating between 2 different disease groups: AD-related & PD-related.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

APPLICANT must be:

- At or above the level of **postdoctoral researcher**
- At a **CRA qualified donee institution** located in Canada

PROJECT must be:

- Development of a **therapeutic** and/or **tool**
- Translational research that helps accelerate the development of therapeutics for neurodegenerative diseases of aging

PD-RELATED diseases:

- Parkinson's disease
- Progressive supranuclear palsy
- Dementia with Lewy bodies
- Multiple system atrophy
- Prodromes to the above
- Vascular contributions to the above
