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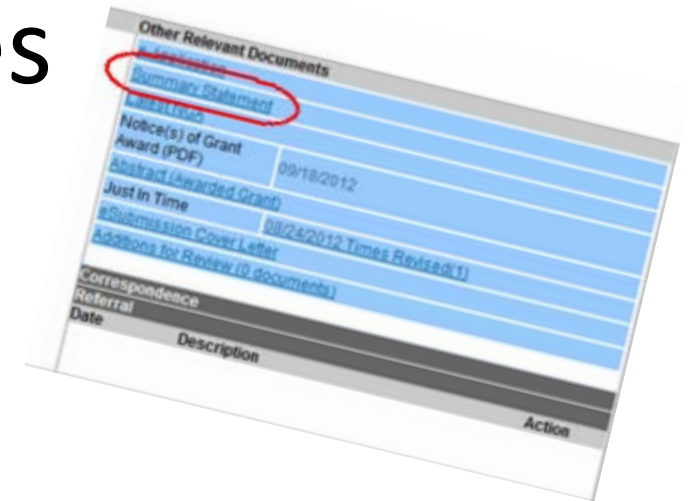

Payment Method

via Payment Management System(PMS)

- ✓ Must be spent within 3 days
- ✓ USD Interest-bearing account

- ✓ Automatic Carry forward

Not-Eligible

- ✓ Annual Progress Report w Budget
- ✓ Annual Financial Report & Final Financial Report
- ✓ Automatic Carry forward

Prior Approval

- **Change in Scope or Aims**
- **Change in Effort of Key Personnel**
removal or reduction of effort <25%
absence for 3 months or more
- **Change in Grantee Institution**
- **Carry-Forward**
Check NOA
- **Adding Foreign Component**

Public Access Policy

Results of Publically Funding Research – Available to Public

- Submit Accepted Final Peer-Reviewed Manuscript to PubMed Central
- Made Publically Available - within 12 months of Publication
- Include PMC ID for papers in all documentation to NIH

Inventions

Governed by Bayle-Dole Act

- Retention of Ownership – Licence to Federal Government
- Agreement to Disclose
- Report New invention – iEdison
- Ownership – Retain or Waive
- Permission to Assign Protection
- License
- Inform



Reporting

Research Performance Progress Report (RPPR)

- Annual Progress Reporting
- Completed in eRA Commons
- 45 or 60 days prior to end date of budget period
- Report on:
 - Accomplishments, Outcomes, Impact, Changes/Problems
- Submission
 - Institution Approves & Submits

No Cost Extension

Initiate 1 year NCE

1. Need to complete project
2. Continuity while requesting renewal
3. Permit phase-out

90 days prior to end date

- Institution processes in eRA Commons
- Automatically issued

Additional NCE require Approval

Closeout

Submitted via eRA Commons:

- ✓ Final Scientific Report
- ✓ Final Financial Report
- ✓ Final Invention & Patent Report

120 days following the end of the grant
