Deadline: EOI must be submitted by September 21, 2020

Available Funding: Overall funding envelope of up to \$30 million is available

This request for expressions of interest is for **population-based studies** that will report on novel data relating to COVID-19 infection and immunity in three types of COVID-19 “hot spots”: 1) geographic areas, 2) long-term care facilities, 3) occupation groups.

Deadline: November 13, 2020

Available Funding: \$8,000-\$15,000

The France Canada Research Fund promotes and finances new research projects in all academic fields, jointly developed by French and Canadian teams that have never worked together before. As a special focus for 2021, however, the FCRF will reserve up to 5 grants for two-year research projects related to the societal impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Deadline: **Rolling Deadline** with response of review within 48 hrs

Available Funding: \$10,000 - \$500,000 to be used solely to expedite COVID-19 related science

Eligibility: PIs at an academic institution already working on a project that could help with the COVID-19 pandemic within the next 6 months
