This includes preparation for and guiding field trips, assisting with development of species identification materials, vetting field trip exercises, managing and cleaning class field data, and marking exercises for 80 students. Field trips include Biology content as well as content integrated with Earth and Environmental Sciences. Must be available for 4-5 field trips, scheduled Thursdays (or Friday afternoons) September-November. Must be available to organize and distribute field equipment prior to scheduled field trips during the fall.

REQUIREMENTS OF POSITION: Minimum upper-level undergraduate student in Biology/Marine Biology, Environmental Science or a related field. Field experience in terrestrial ecology, marine biology, and biodiversity, with expertise in identification of a wide range of species (plants, lichen, macroalgae, and macroinvertebrates) is essential.
