

Procedures for Revising a Minor - Faculty of Science (revised 7-May-2017)

A. General Description of Minors

Minor subjects permit students to engage in areas of limited specialization in addition to their major degree program(s). Minors require a minimum of 18 credit hours above the 1000-level. Students may declare more than one Minor, but no course can count toward more than one Minor (and no course can count toward a Major and a Minor). Advising for disciplinary and subspecialty Minors will normally be handled by departmental program advisors. Interdisciplinary Minors must have a designated hosting department and Coordinator/advisor. New Minors must be approved by the Faculty of Science Curriculum Committee (FoS CC), the Dean of Science, and Senate and its committees. **Course requirements for Minors can be updated on an ongoing basis through requests to FoS CC**.

B. Description of Minor Options

1. Disciplinary Minors

- are general minors within departments or programs (e.g., Minor in Chemistry, Minor in Statistics)
- cannot be combined with a major in the same program
- can be combined with other minors

2. Subspecialty Minors

- are specialized minors within departments or programs
- cannot be combined with a major in the same program
- require a rationale explaining how the proposed subspecialty comprises a discrete minor
- require the support of the Chair of department that will offer the minor

3. Interdisciplinary Minors

- require courses to be taken in more than one department or program
- may require or permit courses to be taken in more than one faculty
- require a rationale for the program
- require a designated coordinator (responsible for advising students and monitoring curriculum)
- require support from the Chairs of all participating departments

C. Procedures for revising Minor requirements

- All changes to Minors that result in changes to the Academic Calendar require Dean's office approval
- Changes to title, course or other requirements, or learning outcomes of Interdisciplinary Minors require departmental (host and participating) and FoS CC approval
- Changes to Disciplinary and Subspecialty Minors require approval by the hosting department. The information will be provided to FoS CC for discussion but the changes do not require CC approval.
- Changes in Coordinator or small wording changes to calendar descriptions of any Minor may be approved by the Dean's office without FoS CC consultation.



Steps:

- 1. Complete a *Minor Revision Request*
- 2. Consult with external department/course instructor if adding one of their courses (contributing dept)
- 3. Obtain approval for revision from host and participating departments
- 4. Submit Revision Request and associated documents to FoS Curriculum committee (Dept rep)
- 5. Revision request considered by FoS CC (vote for interdisciplinary; no vote for disciplinary, subspecialty; small changes approved by Dean's office)
- 6. Host Dept initiator enters the new information in Navigator, submits to Dean's office
- 7. Dean's office approves and submits to RO

Dept rep: Departmental representative, member of the Faculty of Science Curriculum Committee

Dept initiator: Person(s) with authority to make departmental course/calendar changes using Navigator Suite

Participating department: Departments/programs **participate** in a Minor by offering courses that are required for that Minor. Changes to a Minor require the signatures of the chairs of all participating departments.

Contributing department: Departments **contribute** by offering one or more elective courses, courses that are not required, but can be counted toward a Minor. Departments and/or course instructors will be consulted if one of their courses is proposed as a new elective course for the Minor.
