The TRANSFORMATION Study aims to improve both the science of primary care performance measurement and the ways those results are reported to practitioners, decision-makers, and the public to encourage improvement within the system. Our team is a multijurisdictional group of researchers, focusing on three comparable health regions in British Columbia, Ontario and Nova Scotia.

This presentation will discuss some of the preliminary findings from patient-experience surveys and initial work that has been done in order to construct seven core primary care dimensions through psychometric analysis.
