The TRANSFORMATION Study aims to improve both the science of primary care performance measurement and the ways those results are reported to practitioners, decision-makers, and the public to encourage improvement within the system. Our team is a multijurisdictional group of researchers, focusing on three comparable health regions in British Columbia, Ontario and Nova Scotia.

This presentation will discuss some of the preliminary findings from patientexperience surveys and initial work that has been done in order to construct seven core primary care dimensions through psychometric analysis.
