RULES AND REGULATIONS

Background

The Scotiabank Ethics in Action Ethical Leadership Award recognizes ethical leaders – those who, through their actions and decisions, large or small, made with respect to either a single, significant event, or over the course of their career, have demonstrated character, courage, and ethical principles. Leaders from any sector – public, private, or not-for-profit, are eligible to be nominated. The winners will serve as an inspiration to other practitioners and to today’s management students.

Eligibility

Nominations are open to Canadian leaders in all sectors - public, private, or not-for-profit. Nominees must consent to the nomination by responding to notification of their nomination in writing. The winner of the Scotiabank Ethical Leadership Award will be announced prior to the Scotiabank Ethics in Action event.

Submission & Requirements

Nomination forms are available at www.dal.ca/EthicsInAction. Please complete the online form. The nomination must clearly articulate the rationale for nominating the individual, and the impact of the nominee’s ethical leadership on others.

Judging Panel

A panel composed of Dalhousie students, faculty members, and Scotiabank senior leaders will judge the submissions.

Award for Honouree

The selected Honouree will be invited to attend an award ceremony (expenses paid) during the Scotiabank Ethics in Action event where they will be named the Ethical Leader for that year. The Honouree must be available to attend in order to receive the award.
