IATUL 2016: Instruction for Authors

37th Annual IATUL Conference in Halifax, Nova Scotia/ June 5-9 2016

Authors who submitted paper proposals that have been accepted by the IATUL Programme Committee are requested to follow these guidelines when submitting your full paper. Your paper will be reviewed before being published on the IATUL website. Authors are responsible for the grammar of their papers.

1. Deadline for submission

A Conference Programme Guide with speaker information and abstracts will be published and distributed to all delegates of the Conference. To ensure that we can publish this on time, please submit a biographical note on the speaker and final abstract to us on or before **March 14, 2016**.

Due to limitation of space in the guide, please keep the length of your biographical note to 500 characters incl. spaces and the abstract to 2,000 characters incl. spaces.

Full text paper and IATUL copyright form no later than April 18, 2016 please.

2. Paper format

- Paper must be submitted in MS-Word-compatible format
- Paper must be written in English
- The paper length should not exceed 4,000 words incl. spaces (approx. 10 A4 pages)
- Paper is to be typed single spaced using Arial font size 10 points
- Pages are to have 25 mm margins (top and bottom) and 30 mm (left and right)
- Do not number the pages
- Do not use headers or footers

3. Paper title

The title of the paper is to be typed in Uppercase Letters (boldface 16 pt) and centered on the page. The author's name in bold letters and centered on the page. Directly under the author's name and also centered is the author's affiliation institution and country, plus email address in Arial font size 10 points.

4. Abstract

Underneath the paper title section, please type the heading "Abstract" and insert the text of the abstract which summarizes the material contained in the paper. Keywords are to be placed after the abstract.

5. Figures and tables

Figures and tables are to be inserted at the appropriate place in the text, centered, numbered consecutively throughout the text, and each should have a caption underneath. Care should be taken that the lettering is not too small. The use of colour in figures and tables is permitted and encouraged.



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6. Acronyms

All acronyms are to be defined the first time they appear.

7. Acknowledgements

The acknowledgement for funding organizations etc., are to be placed in a separate section at the end of the text.

8. References

Authors are requested to use the APA referencing style. Details are available at <http://www.apastyle.org>. The list of references must be ordered alphabetically according to the first author surname. All references are to be cited in the text, and using square brackets.

9. IATUL's copyright policy

IATUL, in line with open access principles, does not claim shared copyright with the author, only a non-exclusive right to publish. IATUL may publish both the abstract and the full-text of the paper on the IATUL Web site. IATUL may also disseminate or license the content of the paper to appropriate third parties.
