Silent Cells examines how psychotropic drugs contribute to the pacification of captives in U.S. state and federal prisons, military warzone prisons and immigrant detention facilities, nursing homes, youth foster system, and the active-duty military. Silent Cells makes both political and theoretical interventions to our understanding of how the government pacifies large and unruly populations in carceral, warfare, and welfare institutions, uncovering patterns of institutional violence that threaten basic human and civil rights.
