### **Delete, Listen, Educate: Alternative Responses to Digital Harassment & Nonconsensual Pornography**

Growing concerns with digital forms of harassment, bullying, and sexual violence have often been responded to with calls for new or increased criminal law sanctions. However, emerging research finds that criminal responses do not adequately address the central needs of many victims or alter the broader contexts in which digital harms take place. Building on both her PhD research on criminal responses to nonconsensual pornography and her postdoctoral work on alternative responses to nonconsensual pornography and digital harassment, in this presentation Dr. Alexa Dodge will detail the limitations of criminal responses to these digital harms and explore the potential of alternative responses.
