Please attach a 500-word personal statement describing your interest in Russian. What drew you to Russian, in what ways have you studied Russian language and culture so far, and how do you plan to continue your studies and make use of the language? How will studying abroad help you achieve your goals academically, professionally, and personally?

PASSPORT CHECK

Passports must be valid for at least three months after your planned date of departure from the European Union. If your passport expires prior to October 7, 2024 you will need to renew your passport as soon as possible.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid for the Russian Program Abroad is limited. You are urged to investigate thoroughly scholarship and loan opportunities on your own campus or through civic groups in your home and school communities. Your campus financial administrator and study abroad advisor can assist you with this.

Along with this application, Dalhousie students may concurrently choose to apply for the Yuri Glazov Award. Note that this award is available only to current Dalhousie students in good academic standing.
