

Study Spanish in Spain

The Study Abroad Programme in Spain gives Dalhousie students the opportunity to spend a semester in the city of Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage site, at one of the oldest universities in Europe, the prestigious **Universidad de Salamanca**, founded in 1218 by King Alfonso IX of Leon.



Duration

10 weeks (5 hours of classes, 5 days a week).

Classes

Spanish language and electives in culture, literature, history, cinema, business, etc.

Accommodations

In family homes, university residences and apartments.

Eligibility

To apply students should have achieved a B1 intermediate level of Spanish.

Credits

Dalhousie will grant 18 credit hours to students who complete their classes in Spain.

Internship Opportunities

Students can undertake Internships as Conversation Assistant Teachers in bilingual primary schools in Salamanca.
