

The **Dalhousie Research Excellence Scholarship** was established in 2024, with \$3.2M dedicated to attracting and supporting new Dalhousie PhD students with exceptional leadership and research potential. Award recipients represent Dalhousie's emerging leaders with significant provincial, national or international impacts expected from their research.

PhD students are the backbone of research and innovation at Dalhousie, driving the university's ability to respond to a wide array of global challenges. They often work in partnership with industry, government and non-government organizations to solve today's most pressing issues in health care, green energy, food security, and sustainable communities, to name a few.

- The awards are valued at \$35,000/year and students may hold the award for up to four years.
- Approximately 30 awards will be issued in 2025. The awards are open to Canadian and international students.
- Specific awards will also be available to support research leaders from the Indigenous community (with priority given to Mi'kmaw applicants) and the African Nova Scotian community.
